Nella Tabella delle azioni é stata aggiunta la colonna "Blocchi logici" che riporta la semantica vicina al "diagramma di flusso". In questo modo il docente, se lo vorrà, seguendo la Tabella, potrà illustrare il diagramma di flusso corrispondente, avviando così, il suo lavoro, per una fase successiva, alla programmazione informatica.[1] Tutti questi aspetti possono essere facilmente integrati in un processo d'insegnamento principale – se inseriti in un contesto ludico e creativo, finalizzato alla risoluzione di situazioni – oppure come strumento educativo supplementare, utilizzabile sia
