

## Mystery Shopping Guide Reviews

Edgar award nominee James N. Frey, author of the internationally best-selling books on the craft of writing, *How to Write a Damn Good Novel*, *How to Write a Damn Good Novel II: Advanced Techniques*, and *The Key: How to Write Damn Good Fiction Using the Power of Myth*, has now written what is certain to become the standard "how to" book for mystery writing, *How to Write a Damn Good Mystery*. He shows them exactly which parts of that world show up in the pages of a damn good mystery-and which parts are held back just long enough to keep the reader guessing.
